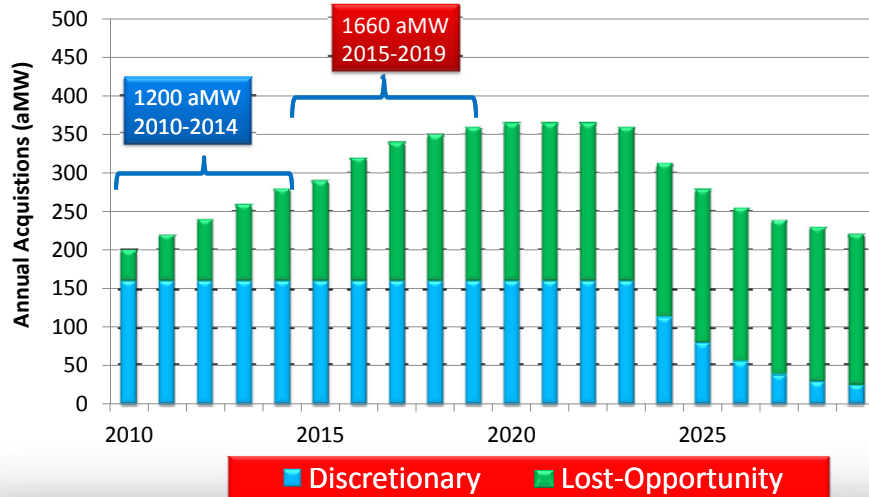
**SUBJECT: Contribution of Federal Standards Adopted Since the Sixth Plan Towards Regional Energy Efficiency Goals**

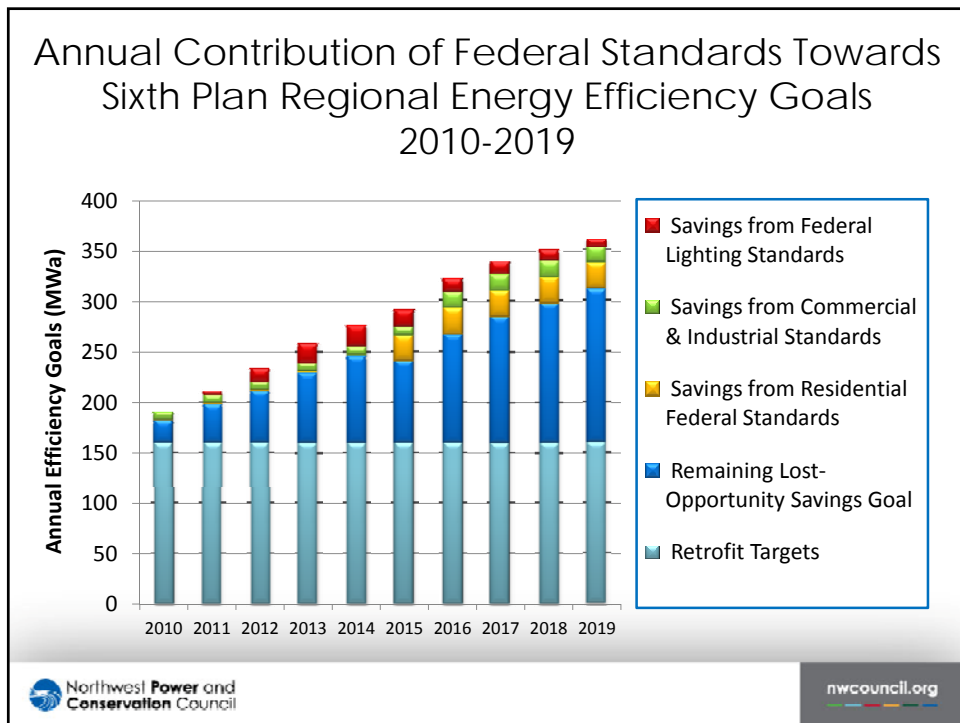
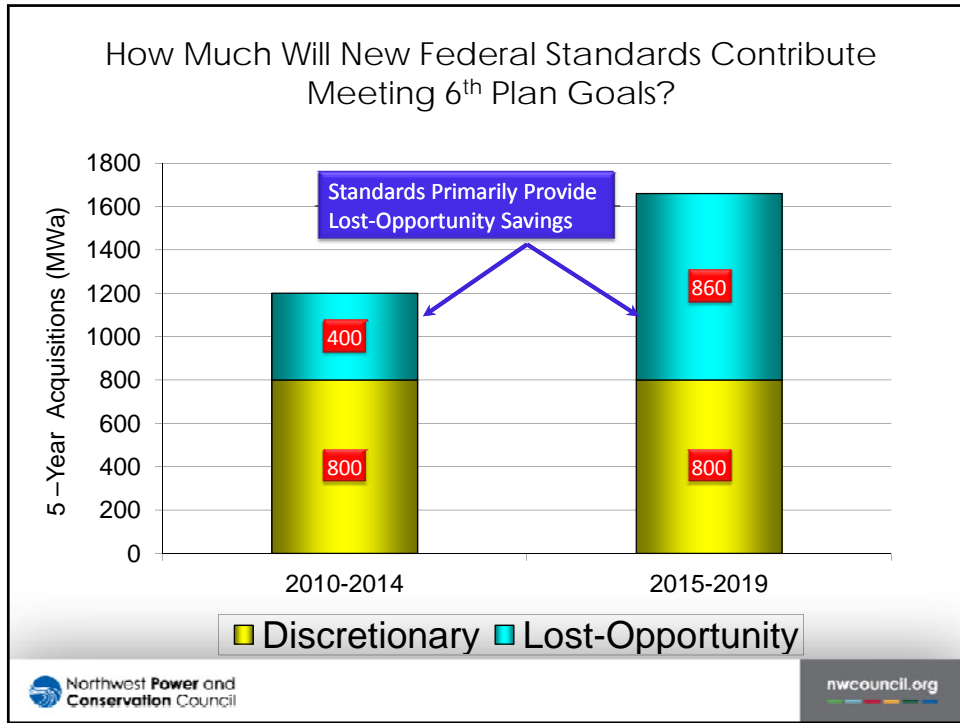
At the May Council meeting staff, presented a summary of the estimated savings from 26 new and revised federal appliance, equipment and lighting standards promulgated since the Council's Sixth Power Plan was adopted. In aggregate, these standards are anticipated to produce approximately 100 average megawatts of cumulative savings by 2014 and an additional 265 average megawatts of cumulative savings by 2019. These new and revised federal standards will contribute about eight percent of the savings needed to meet the Sixth Plan's conservation goals through 2014 and approximately sixteen percent towards the Sixth Plans conservation goals for 2015 through 2019. At the June meeting staff will brief the Power Committee on these estimated impacts.

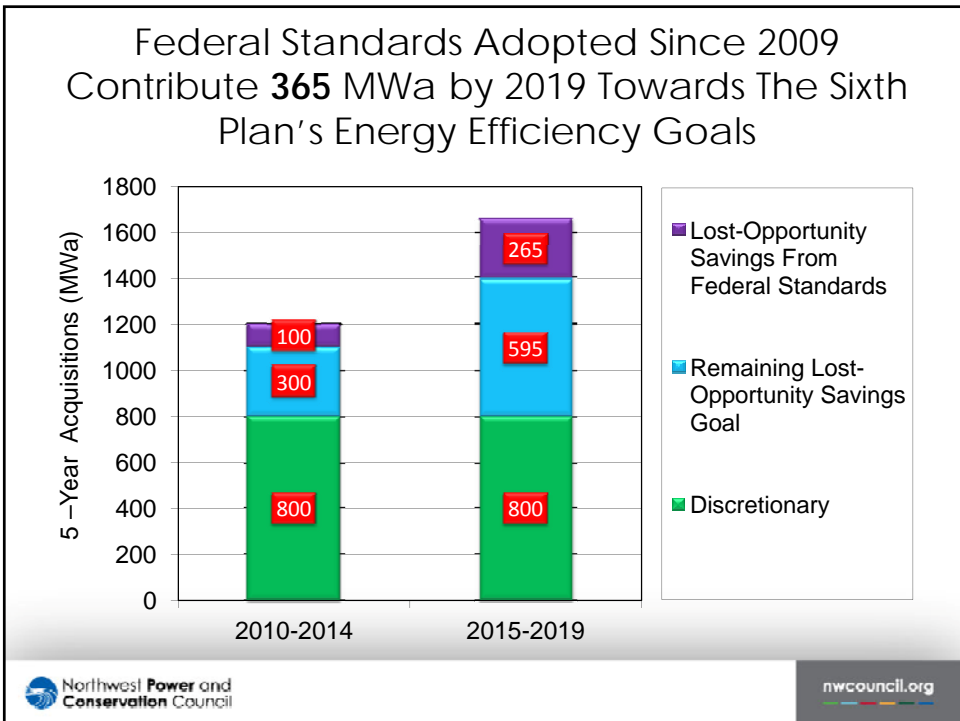
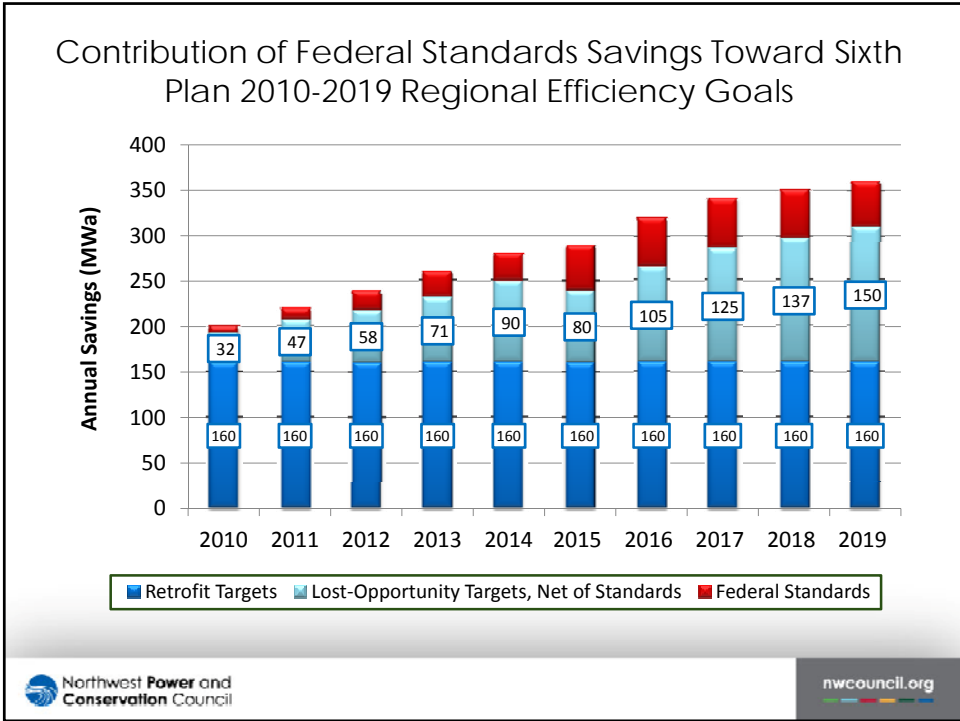
